



Egypt, Indra, and ELINT-FD radars

Reports from Cairo suggest that talks are currently underway between the Egyptian Ministry of Military Production and Spanish defense company Indra for the procurement of ELINT-FD radar systems.

The ELINT-FD all-weather radar provides pulse and intrapulse detailed analysis and identification of radar signals as well as provide guidance and technical characterization and analysis of the battlefield.

Egypt is interested in acquiring 7 ELINT-FD systems. Three of the systems will be mounted on vehicles, while the rest will come in detachable modules that can be integrated into military vessels.

The Egyptian Military Production Ministry and Indra will also sign a license agreement whereby Egypt would be allowed to produce of local variant of the vehicle-mounted ELINT-DF system.

Indra will provide Egyptian engineers with technical training and assistance in this regard.

Sources close to the situation say that Egypt will install four of the radars on the Egyptian Navy's new Gowind-class corvettes that were manufactured at Alexandria Shipyard, as well as on two similar corvettes that are expected to be acquired soon.
