PAKISTAN MILITARY ACADEMY



LOCATION

Abbotabad is situated 120Kms North West of the Federal Capital. Nestled in the foothills of the Himalayas, the picturesque valley is known throughout Pakistan for its pleasant weather, flora, fauna, high-standard education and military establishments; in addition it attracts thousands of tourists.

HISTORY

Established in 1947 at Kakul, soon after the country's creation. The First Pakistan Battalion was instituted on 25 January 1946, with the pioneering companies named after Islamic Military Luminaries. On March, 1948, the Father of the Nation bestowed his patronage as Colonel in Chief and most coveted claim "Quaid-e-Azam's Own" Its First Passing Out was overseen by Khwaja Nazimuddin (Governor General) who presented the Quaid-e-Azam's Banner (since held by the champion company). The institution has expanded through the wars, with additional Battalions being raised.

Duration - Two Years (Four Terms of Six Months Each), May and October Entries

GRADUATE COURSE

Eligibility - Bachelors Degree
Medium of Instruction - English
Duration - One Year (Two Terms of Six Months Each), May and October Entries

TECHNICAL GRADUATE COURSE

Eligibility - Bachelors Degree
Medium of Instruction - English
Duration - One Year (Two Terms of Six Months Each), May and October Entries

INTEGRATED COURSE

Eligibility - Masters Degree
Medium of Instruction - English
Duration - Six Months, May and October Entries

LADY CADET COURSE

Eligibility - Masters / Bachelor Degree
Medium of Instruction - English
Duration - Six Months (Once a year from May to Oct)

ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSE

Eligibility - Higher Secondary School / A levels / American High School / Equivalent
Medium of Instruction - English
Duration - Six Months / One Year, depending on language proficiency

CONCEPT OF TRAINING

Communication Skills. Emphasis is laid to develop listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. PMA's performance at National Declamation Contests and Model United Nations are a sure testimony.

Clubs. Variety of Indoor and Outdoor clubs satiate Cadets interests in curricular and extra curricular discipline. Clubs include Polo and Saddle, Camera, Debating, Rock Climbing and Fencing etc.



Model Discussions. Tactical situations are discussed as a group activity. Activation of mental process leads to conceptual clarity and promotes readiness for field operations.

Teaching Exercises. Tactical demonstrations followed by field exercises on major and minor operations are conducted in outdoor training facilities of the campus to perfect drills and procedures before major exercises.
